April at Sittingbourne's Steam Railway

The late Easter weekend sees a change of pace at Sittingbourne's Steam Railway. Avoid the crowds and visit the Railway on Sundays 7th, 14th and 28th when trains will be departing Sittingbourne Viaduct hourly 1-4pm or come along over the Easter Weekend which will be 'Four Days of Steam' with trains departing Sittingbourne Viaduct station hourly from 11am until 4pm all four days.

Four Days of Steam starts on Good Friday, passengers will be able to pot a plant plug and decorate a sleeve to go around the pot (whilst stocks last) and take them home afterwards.

On Easter Sunday there will be an Easter Egg Hunt at Kemsley Down, please allow two hours for your visit as the hunt can be quite time consuming but there is a small prize at the end of it!

Sunday 28th April will be an ordinary Sunday, this could be a good time to visit to take part in the Railway's Wheels of Time task and collect the Railway's exclusive badge, please allow two hours for your visit to complete this.

The return fares for 2019 are:

- Adults - £7
- Concessions - £6
- Child (aged 3-15) - £3.50
- Under 3s go free
- Family (2 adults and up to 4 children) - £20

Special fares and timetable apply for Steam & Beer. Other fares are available, such as single tickets, to enable passengers to walk one way via Milton Creek Country Park and the Saxon Shore Way.
