

Special Events

Finding the Railway

By Road - for sat. nav. use ME10 2XD

From the M2 (J5) or M20 (J7), follow A249 towards Sheerness and take the second Sittingbourne exit, at Bobbing, then follow signs for B2006 and Town Centre. At B2006 Mill Way roundabout you will have Milton Regis Viaduct in front of you, turn right and follow the brown heritage signs to Sittingbourne Viaduct station (within Sittingbourne Retail Park).

Please note that Milton Regis (Asda) Halt remains closed until further notice, due to vandalism.

There is no road access to Kemsley Down station, however, there is pedestrian access to/from the Saxon Shore Way footpath (except during Steam & Beer and Santa Specials).

Sittingbourne National Rail station is well served by classic and High Speed services operated by Southeastern from London Victoria, St. Pancras International, the Medway Towns, Kent Coast and Sheerness. Sittingbourne Viaduct station is just a few minutes walk away, within Sittingbourne Retail Park.

From arriving at Sittingbourne Viaduct station and its Marvellous Mural through to the trip over the century-old, kilometre-long, Milton Regis Viaduct and through Milton Creek Country Park to Britain's biggest paper mill at Kemsley Down, a journey on Sittingbourne's Steam Railway is quite unique!

The Railway operates over the southern half of the former paper mill industrial railway system using original steam locomotives and rolling stock.

The narrow (2ft 6in) gauge steam locomotives Leader, Melior and Superb will take turns to operate trains throughout the season.

The journey takes 15 minutes in both directions so a round trip can take as little as an hour. Kemsley Down is the main base for the Railway and here you will find the engine shed, sidings, small exhibits museum,

Footplate Café, shop, picnic areas and award winning wildlife garden. Feel free to stay for a while and catch a later train home to enjoy the facilities.

We aim to be an affordable, family-friendly day out that also caters for railway enthusiasts, local and industrial historians.

The Railway is run entirely by volunteers and we are always looking for more help, not just with the operation of the Railway but also the maintenance and upkeep of the entire two-mile site.
